## WHAT IS STREPTOCOCCUS?

Streptococcus is a germ that lives naturally on the human body. Sometimes, the germ can cause strep throat. If left untreated, the sore throat can progress to another illness called scarlet fever.

red, sore throat

swollen tonsils

stomach pain

fever  
rash

## HOW CAN I GET SICK?

Coming into close contact with a sneeze or cough from someone who currently has a sore throat

Drinking or eating on the same utensils after someone who has a sore throat

## HOW CAN I STAY SAFE?



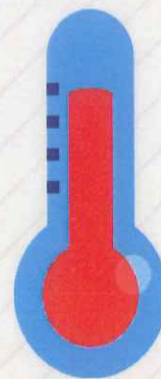
Cover your mouth when you cough or sneeze. Use a tissue when sneezing

Wash your hands after you blow your nose, cough, or sneeze

See your provider if you have symptoms of a sore throat
